Result 4♥ by West, -2, +100 NS

In the second trick South revoked.

Ruling

South revoked in the second trick: did not follow suit (♥) and discarded a ♣. This revoke became established at the moment North played in the following trick (Law 63A1). South (player who revoked) did not win the trick of the revoke but NS did win tricks afterwards, one of which they have to transfer to EW (Law 64A2).

Decision

The result reached at the table is annulled and replaced by the adjusted score $4 \checkmark$ by West, -1, +50 for NS.

There is no ground to apply Law 64C as NS will normally win two tricks in \spadesuit and two in \spadesuit , so that the result would also be -1.

The balance on board 27 then is +190 for Team A (instead of 240), being +5 IMPs for Team A instead of +6 IMPs.

The final result of the match **Phenix 2 – Riviera 2** then is 85-93 in IMPs (instead of 86-93) or 8,5-11,50 in VPs (instead of 8,68-11,32).
