Reopening : 10-14 on minor open, 12-16 on major
<b>JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
1 suit: weak not vul; intermediate vul
2 suiter: Michaëls: Cue=Highst + other; 2NT=2 lowest
Reopen: Intermediate 6 card
<b>DIRECT &amp; JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)</b>
At 2 level: Michaëls
At 3 level: asks for stopper
