OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Classical 7-17HL
Response: New suit with jump = nat fit showing
Cue 11+, Jump cue 4 cards 11+
1/1 F1, 2/1 NF except 2♥ over 1♠! F1
Balancing non jump suit = same as overcall
1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
1NT = 15+-18H (reopening : 9-15)
2SA = reopening: 17-19H
Responses
After 1♣/ 1♦ : idem 1NT opening / id on 2NT nat
After 1♠/1♥ : everything in transfer/id on 2NT nat
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Suit = preempt except 1M - 3♣ ! Maj'+♦
2NT = two-suiter 2 weakest
1♣-2♦=5/5Maj
Reopen: natural
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Direct : Two-suiter Ghestem style +1♣-2♣= 5/5 ♦♠
Jump : asking for stop
Reopen : Direct = two-suiter (Maj on 1min) on min Maj'+min'
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Vs Strong : Multi-Landy (x = min/Maj or ♦ or strong major)
Vs Weak : x = stronger than the opener, other = Multi Landy
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
X = negative (2NT= mini cue-bid or GF with OM/cue GF no interest in OM)
2M – 4m = m + M' 2M – 3M = stop asking or Two-suiter in minor
3Maj 4min= Min 5+ Maj', 3 min-4min= Maj, 3min-4min'=min'+♥
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
X= Majors, 1NT = min; others nat
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
Truscott on Maj- Inverted Truscott on min
Cappelletti on Maj and jump fit-showing
