GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE

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|--|
| 5 card Majors, 4 card diamonds |
| T-Walsh // 1D-1H = Spades // 1D-1S = Hearts |
| 2♣ 5F Major or 6-C or 5-C + 4cM weak // 2♦ Multi, GF minor or 6cM weak |
| 2M 5cM + 4c minor weak |
| Balanced minimum opening 12 hp ; less in 3th hand |
| 1NT 15-17, normally no 5cM |
| 2 over 1 responses : 10+ hp |
| Transfer preempts ; 2-suited overcalls ; many transfer bids |

SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENCE

| 2♣ : 6-C or 5C + 4cM weak // 2♦ Multi |
| 3♣/3♦/3♥ transfer preempt or GF one/two suiter |
| 3♠ : Gambling, closed minor |
| 3NT : preempt clubs |
| T-Walsh : after 1C-opening Ms are bid in transfer |
| Durex : after 1D-opening Ms are interchanged |
| Buni bicolor overcalls : 54+ two suiter ; (1x)-1NT, two lowest // (1M)-2m, 5m+4oM // (1D)-2C, 5cC+4cS // (1m)-2m, Majors // (1M)-2M, good minor, 6card |
| Bicolor can sometimes be 44 with stronger hand and/or when infoDBL is not possible |
| Gorilla : competitive 2NT-bid |
| Absolute Doubles : desire to compete on game level or higher |
| World-Convention : strong two suiters after preempt |

SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES

IMPORTANT NOTES THAT DON'T FIT ELSEWHERE

Modifications in 3rd hand : 2M can be without 4card minor and preempts can more often be 6-card

Psychics : very rare, only when opps are unfriendly :-)
