OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
On 1♣: 1♦/1♥ TEX, 1♠ 4+♦4+♠, 1NT 4+♦4+♥, 2♣ 4+♥4+♠
On 1♦: NAT but INT 4+♣4+♥, 2♣ 4+♣4+♠, 2♦ 4+♥4+♠
On 1M: NAT but 1SA: 4+4+m, 2m: 4+m4+othM
Reopening : NAT
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2 nd position : see above; 4 th position live : 15-17; reopening position 10 – 14 on 1m, 12-16 on 1M
Responses : Stayman/Transfers
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Style : good opening .
Unusual NT on M= ♣/♦, on m: ♥/m'
Reopen: Style : intermediate ; Unusual NT = 20-22 (1M) 23-24 (1m)
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Direct cue bid on M : 2 suiter M'♣ - on m: 4+4+ M
Jump cue bid on M: asks stopper – on ♣: Nat – on ♦ – 5+5+M
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Strong: X = ♣ or Landy, 2♣ = ♦ ; 2♦ Multi ; 2♥/♠ Nat+4+m, 2NT 2-suit, 3x Pre
Weak : X penalty in 2 nd / take out optional in 4 nd ,
2♣ = ♥/♠ ; 2x Texas, 3x Nat strong
VS.PREEMPTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
Doubles = take-out till 4♥
Jumps & NT bids : NAT, strong
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
X = ♥, 1♦ = ♠, 1♥ = ♥+m, 1♠ = ♠+m, 1SA= ♥+♠, 2x= 6+Nat, 2SA = minors
