

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
<b>OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)</b>
General style: Natural and sound
Responses of advancer in new suit: nat. forcing below cue-bid transfers as from cue-bid
Weak jump raises
Other jumps: natural with fit in overcalled suit
Reopening: natural 8-12, but see Doubles; 1NT 10-13, 2NT 19-20
<b>1NT OVERCALL (2<sup>nd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)</b>
2 <sup>nd</sup> . & 4 <sup>th</sup> position: 15-18 HCP
Responses Stayman and Transfers
<b>JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
Style: natural and weak
Unusual NT: two lower unbid suits
Reopening: 2♥ over 1♦ = 10-12, 5+hearts
<b>DIRECT &amp; JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)</b>
Direct cue-bid: 1m 2m = Majors; 1M 2M = other Major + min
Responses : 2NT asks for second suit
Jump cue-bid: ask for stopper
<b>VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)</b>
X = 5 <sup>+</sup> minor, 4 Major or diamonds
2♣ both majors; 2♦ long Major; 2♥/♠ 5 card Major-4+minor
2NT : any strong 5-5
Reopening : same
Vs. weak NT : same except X = 15 <sup>+</sup>
<b>VS. PREEMPTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)</b>
Vs. 2♦ multi: X: take-out - other natural
Vs. 2M: X: take-out - 4m: 2 suiter m+otherM – other nat.
<b>VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣</b>
Vs. 1♣ strong: X: 13+ take-out - 1♦: a 5-card major
1♥/1♠/1NT: 2-suiter same col./rank/mixed - 2x: natural(0-12)
2x : 6 OR 1 card in x = (semi) 3-suiter
<b>OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE</b>
