Level 2 : 11-16 6 cards, 13-16 5 top cards
X : short 11H+/ 18+ all hands
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2nd : 16-18, stop in opp. suit
4th : 11-14
Responses : same as opening
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Natural, 6-10, good hand red v green
