<b>GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE</b>
Tendancy 5 card major
1♣ may be 2
1♦ usually a good 4 card
1NT 15(14)-17
2 over 1 responses: forcing one-round
Namyats
<b>SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE</b>
2♣ : weak ♦, balanced 23-24, any Game Forcing
2♦ : weak ♥, semi-forcing ♣, ♦, or ♠
2♥ : weak ♠ or semi-forcing ♥
2♠ : Muyderberg 5♠ and 4 (5) in a minor (shows 5-5, when vulnerable)
3NT : closed minor (does not promise anything else)
4 minor: Namyats
4NT good minor 2-suiter
<b>SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES</b>
After our opening, D and RD: Pass is forcing till 3♦
<b>IMPORTANT NOTES</b>
Reverse bids forcing
3 <sup>rd</sup> scat opening may be light
