General style natural 1x 8-16H 5 cards, 2x without jump 11-16H 6 cards, 2x with jump weak
Responses : new suit (1/1 or 2/2) F1, 2/1 NF
Cue bid F1
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2 nd : 16-18HL, same answers than on an opening
4 th : 11-14 HL
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Nat and weak
2 suits on minor opening : 2♦ both majors, 2NT low ones, 3♣ last 2
2 suits on Maj op : 2M = M' and ♣, 2NT the min, 3♣ M'/♦

Weak NT : Mohan (x shows 15+H, 2♣ Landy, 2♦♥♠ Nat, 2NT 5♠+/5♦+)

Nat overcall, jump/cue shows 2 suits, double shows a good opening
