| VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣ |
| vs strong 1♣: DBL=MM, 1♦=5m+4♠; 1M=NAT; 1NT=6+c m; 2m=5+c m+4♥; 2M= 6+c M, 2NT= 5+/5+ mm |
| OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE |
| 1NT-DBL (if DBL strong):2♣-DBL: opener is forced to pass, responder takes lead; 2♦/♥: TRF; RDBL: 8+; 2♠: 5+/5+ mm |
| 1x-DBL-RDBL: high power |
