

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING

OVERCALLS - General style: *Natural*

Responses *other suit: forcing except 2/1,*

Jump: nat + fit, Cue = force.

IN THE REOPENING POSITION: 7-11H

Responses *cue-bid forcing*

TAKE-OUT DOUBLE - general style *12⁺H except two suiter*

Responses : *cue-bid forcing, jump 8-10; 1NT 7-10*

IN THE REOPENING POSITION *8⁺H*

Responses *cue-bid forcing*

1NT OVERCALL 2pos.:15-18;4pos.10-14
Resp.:texas+cue-bid

JUMP OVERCALL: Maj:4-10 or 11-14(red)
