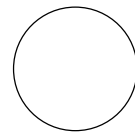

Underline leads against suit contracts if different	

SYSTEM SUMMARY: GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE
Strong club, 5-card majors, 1NT with 5+♦
strength of opening bids depends on vulnerability

USE 1 = ODD NO. OF CARDS, 2 = EVEN NO. OF CARDS					
D = DISCOURAGING, E = ENCOURAGING, S = SUIT PREFERENCE					
BRACKET THE SIGNALING SYMBOL WHEN RARELY USED

next four bids = that suit and next suit up (NT for remaining 2-suiter)
