

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
<b>OVERCALLS (Style; Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)</b>
5+ cards suits, 10H+ 2 <sup>nd</sup> hand, 8H+ 4 <sup>th</sup> hand
Reponses to 2 <sup>nd</sup> hand : support like on opening bid, cue bid on overcall major suit : fitted, very strong, cue bid on overcall minor suit : ask control on opening bid suit to access NT contract, other natural
Reponses to 4 <sup>nd</sup> hand : same but +2H
<b>INT OVERCALL (2<sup>nd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)</b>
2 <sup>nd</sup> hand : 16-18H, opening suit control. Responses like 1NT opening
4 <sup>nd</sup> hand : 10-12H, opening suit control.
<b>JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
Major suit : 6-10 H, 6+ cards. Responses like on major level 2 Opening bid
Minor suit : barrier

Michael's two-coloured overcalls
<b>VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)</b>
