

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Responses :
1 NT = 9-12 HP jump fit not constructive
cue-bid = 1 round force, usually with a fit
new suit at same level = 1 round F
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
In 2 nd hand : 16-18 HP (may be underweight w/long minor)
resp. - as on 1NT opening if 1 st hand bid a minor suit
- Texas (transfer bids) if 1 st hand bid a major suit
In 4 th hand : 4M-5/6m when opponents have bid 2 suits
In reopening position 10-12 (13) HP
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Ghestem 2-suiters
Other jump overcalls : pre-emptive
In reopening position : natural NF
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Ghestem 2-suiters
2♣ over 1♣ natural
Jump cue-bid : looking for a stopper
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
2 nd hand :
▪ double showing 5 min and 4 maj
▪ 2♣ --> Landy
▪ 2♠ 2♥ Muyderberg
*2♦ 6 cards Maj
Against weak NT double is penalty oriented
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
over standard pre-empts : double is for takeout
over major weak-2 : conventional bids to show distribution
over multi 2♦ : bidding short major for takeout
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
2♣ on 1♣ is natural
double of 1♣ is for takeout
double of 2♣ suggests defence
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
major openings : keeping Bergen answers
minor opening : bid at the 1 level = one round force
2NT weak fit 3-level fit constructive

SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE
▪ Stayman 2♣ not forcing and possibly without major suit
▪ 2♦ on 1 Maj opening may be a weak supporting hand
▪ Bergen answers when fitting 1 major opening
▪ 1NT overcall when opponents have bid 2 suits shows a
4M-5/6m distribution in the other 2 suits (polish NT)
▪ responder new suit over intervention is forcing
unless initial pass
▪ 3 rd and 4 th suit forcing
SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES
IMPORTANT NOTES
trial bid is usually in "need help" suit but doesn't
warrant a weak spot
PSYCHICS: 3 rd seat openings may be light
