Style: natural, always good color, 5 card
Responses: fit showing cur: forcing round
Reopening:natural 5 card , 1NT 15-17 HP
x : take out + later bid 17 +
1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses, Reopening)
2 nd position: (14)15-18p resp. see 1NT
Responses: n same as opening 1NT
4 th position: 15-17p
Responses: same as on 1nt
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style, Responses, Unusual NT)
Style: 1-suit : weak 6 card
2-suit : Michaels
Responses: natural
Unusual notrump: Michaels , two lowest colors
DIRECT and JUMP CUE BIDS (Style, Resp., Reopening)
Style: Michaels
jump : asks for stopper to play 3NT
Responses: natural
Reopening: same
VS. NT (vs. Strong / Weak; Reopening; PH)
Strong & Weak: 2cl: min 4/4 minor; 2dia: min 4/4 major; 2ha/2sp : unicolor; DBL:unicolor,resp:2cl pass or correct
Weak: double=14+. 2ha/sp=opening
Reopening: same
Passed Hand:same
VS. PREEMPTS (Doubles, Cue-bids, Jumps, NT bids)
cuebid : asks for stopper
Vs weak2,multi & muiderberg:2NT=15-18HP,DBL=take-out 11-16 or +16HP unicolor;color is nat.opening;2x/dbl/2nt/3cl
3NT to play: 18+
