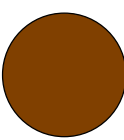

Responses 2NT good/bad if double at 2-level

Circle opening leads vs no-trumps	SAME LEADS IF OUR SIDE SHOWED SUIT
Underline leads against suit contracts if different	

SYSTEM SUMMARY: GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE
Strong club, 5-card majors, 1NT with 5+♦
strength of opening bids depends on vulnerability

UNUSUAL NT only in 2nd live: 5-5 higher suits

agreements about obvious shit [p. 39]
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SPECIAL COMPETITIVE BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE

SPECIAL, ARTIFICIAL AND COMPETITIVE DOUBLES	
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Lightner double
after intervention above 2M if we have M fit, double is a trial

CB. 5	CB. 6
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VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG 1 ♣ or 2 ♣ OPENINGS
double = 2-suiter of non-touching suits
next four bids = that suit and next suit up (NT for remaining 2-suiter)
